






Did you participate in the #Everythingisawesome challenge?

 - Forced them to recall the material
 - Some cite being visual learners
- 100% of non-participants said it would have if they participated
- 100% of non-participants said they learned from weekly reviews of others' drawings







FERPA and Senate Bill 1349

- Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act
 - ✓ Student academic information
 - ✓ Student directory information

- Senate Bill 1349
 - ✓ Student Username and Password




Don't discuss student grades and other academic information on Twitter

- Don't ask students for their usernames or passwords
 - ✓ Keep track of Twitter postings via a hashtag
 - ✓ Use Twitter Search to find student submissions
 - ✓ Assign Student profiles to a private Twitter list
 - ✓ Use the Twitter Like feature for record keeping






Q-How would you react to these possible items Discovered by reviewing a candidate's social Network profile?

	Positive	Neutral	Negative
Referencing to doing illegal drugs	1%	7%	83%
Posts/Tweets of sexual nature	1%	16%	71%
Profanity in posts/tweets	4%	20%	65%
Spelling/grammar errors in posts/tweets	3%	29%	61%
References to guns	1%	31%	51%
Pictures of consumption of alcohol	1%	39%	47%
Volunteering/donations to charity	65%	26%	1%
Political posts/tweets	2%	65%	18%
Overly religious posts/tweets	2%	55%	28%
